OPIOID FNL PREVENTION EDUCATION EFFORTS:

ALMOST ALL COUNTIES REPORTED THAT THEY WERE INVOLVED IN OPIOID PREVENTION EFFORTS. THE FOLLOWING WERE THE VARIOUS TYPES OF EDUCATION EFFORTS:
PRESCRIPTION DRUG/OPIOID EDUCATION (FOR PUBLIC AS WELL AS MEDICAL PROFESSIONALS)
LOCK-UP EFFORTS
TAKE BACK EVENTS
MEDICALLY ASSISTED TREATMENT EDUCATION
INVOLVEMENT IN HARM REDUCTION COALITION AND MEETINGS

THE MOST COMMON ACTIVITY REPORTED WAS PRESCRIPTION DRUG EDUCATION, THOUGH SEVERAL COUNTIES REPORTED ENGAGING IN MULTIPLE EDUCATION EFFORTS. THE LEAST COMMON ACTIVITY WAS MEDICALLY ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT).

THERE WERE SEVEN COUNTIES THAT REPORTED THAT THEY HAVE **NOT** BEEN INVOLVED IN SUCH EFFORTS (TEHAMA, SAN FRANCISCO, MARIN, ORANGE, SAN JOAQUIN, AMADOR, FRESNO). HOWEVER, APPROXIMATELY HALF OF THESE REPORTED THAT THEY WOULD BE INTERESTED IN LEARNING MORE ABOUT HOW THEY COULD GET INVOLVED IN OPIOID PREVENTION EFFORTS.
